Trey arrived to our young adult group in winter 2024 and when he walked in he was immediately accepted by the others.

"The sign outside says community, I can attest to that," he said during one group a few months later.

With some new group members, they wait to share. Not with Trey. He immediately began sharing his story. He was looking for community, a support system at this point in his life.

"I'm a 3-times childhood cancer survivor. After my relapse, I received a bone marrow transplant from my brother. Finally, at 21 my thyroid was removed. I'm 29 now and in full remission."

We looked at him, not quite sure how to respond - and at the same time feeling a great amount of compassion.

Currently, he lives with his brother in an apartment and is exploring educational and professional opportunities.

In fact, he has a passion for helping people. Currently, he's studying to be a phlebotomist and also seeking other ways to be of support to people.

In a recent group he said, "I just feel like we're all here to learn something. Like the earth is a school for souls. We're all learning here."

Trey offers compassion, authenticity and support to the others in group.

And he's right. We're all here to learn something about ourselves and our lives. Hopefully, learning never ends.
